Sunray for Children is governed by a board of trustees responsible for the charity's strategic direction and governance.

During 2023, **Svetlana Martineková stepped down from her role as trustee due to family reasons**, and the trustees expressed appreciation for her contribution to the organisation.

Objectives and Activities

The charity continued providing guidance and informational support to Slovak and Czech families living in England and Wales.

Support was provided primarily through:

- telephone consultations
- email communication
- video consultations

The organisation helps families understand social services, family law processes and available support resources.

Achievements and Performance

During 2023 the charity organised a creative international project "**Deň slnka**" (**Day of the Sun**) in cooperation with the organisation **Lúč pre dieťa**.

Children from around the world participated by submitting drawings, crafts, poems and other creative works.

Hundreds of children participated and each child received a certificate of participation.

The charity also continued providing guidance and support to families experiencing difficult circumstances.
