### About the Organisation

Sunray for Children is a UK registered charity supporting Slovak and Czech families living in England and Wales who are facing difficult life situations.

The organisation provides guidance and informational support to families navigating the UK social system, family law and challenging personal circumstances.

Most services are delivered through telephone consultations, email communication and video calls, ensuring that support is accessible to families across the United Kingdom.

### Our Mission

Our mission is to support families in vulnerable situations, helping them access information, guidance and appropriate support services so that children can grow up in safe and stable environments.

---

### Our Impact (2022–2025)

Since its establishment, Sunray for Children has supported many families through guidance and informational assistance.

#### Support Provided to Families

- **Email consultations:** 32 clients
- **Telephone consultations:** 142 clients
- **Video consultations:** 15 clients

#### Duration of Support

- **Short-term cases (up to 6 months):** 64 clients
- **Long-term cases (over 6 months):** 44 clients
- **Cases lasting more than 1 year:** 13 clients

The charity continues to provide ongoing support where families require longer-term assistance.

## Community and Cultural Activities

Sunray for Children supports community engagement and cultural initiatives that strengthen connections among Slovak families abroad.

### International Children's Project

In cooperation with the organisation **Lúč pre dieťa**, the charity organised the international creative project "**Deň slnka**" (**Day of the Sun**).

Children from around the world participated by creating drawings, poems, songs, crafts and other creative works.

Hundreds of children participated and each received a **certificate of participation**.

## Cultural Engagement

The charity participated in **folklore workshops**, presenting Slovak cultural traditions including **felted crafts and traditional costume presentation during a fashion show**.

These activities help promote Slovak cultural heritage and strengthen community bonds.

## International Cooperation

Representatives of Sunray for Children participated in an **international conference in Slovakia** organised by the sister charity **Lúč pre dieťa**, supporting international cooperation in helping families and children.

---

## Recognition

At a special event held at the **Slovak Embassy**, **Dagmar Szabo**, founder and Chair of Sunray for Children, received a **Letter of Appreciation from the Ambassador of Slovakia** in recognition of long-term dedicated volunteer work supporting families and communities.

---

## Governance

Sunray for Children is governed by a board of trustees and operates according to established organisational policies including:

- Financial Controls Policy
- Risk Management Policy

These policies ensure responsible governance, transparency and compliance with UK charity regulations.
